Each home owner is required to work 300 hours, with 100 of those hours worked prior to being accepted as a Partner Family. Habitat Homes are not hand outs, but rather a hand up. Each Partner Family works to be accepted, and re-pays a monthly mortgage at 0% interest after closing.

Ron Steele is our Celebrity Emcee and our Celebrity Auctioneer is Gary Kroeger. Both Ron and Gary have supported this chapter for many years; we are delighted to have them back; and we are looking forward to another successful and lively auction. Thank you, both, for your continued commitment to us.

A special thanks goes to the volunteers from the college Habitat Chapters. They did item carry-in, valet parking, item carry-out and clean up! Thank you for making this event possible!

We hope that you enjoy yourselves this evening.
